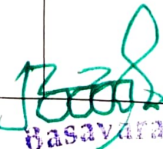

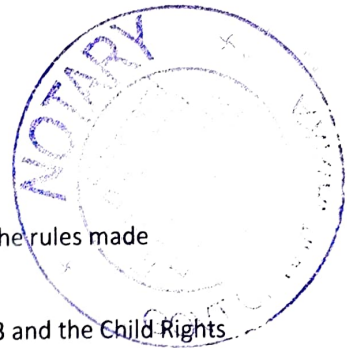
Conditions:

1. Under the Child Rights Education Act, 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act, 1983 and the rules made thereunder.
2. The school shall function under the rules framed under the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the Child Rights Education Act 2009.
3. Child Rights Education Act 2009 to reserve 25% seats for weaker section children under the rules framed thereunder. The Government has the authority to enrol the reserved seats under RTE for the schools covered by RTE. [Government has made rules to facilitate the enrolment of children in neighbouring schools where their parents live, according to which, if there are government and government-funded educational institutions, children will be enrolled in that school] Otherwise, private schools will enrol children enrolled by the government and allow them to continue their education up to the primary level. To enable these children to continue their education without any discrimination.
4. Government releases fees of children enrolled under RTE rule as described in clause 3. Hence it has stopped charging any fees from these children.

Conditions:

1. The school is registered under the Child Rights Education Act-2009, and the Karnataka Education Act-1983 and in accordance with the rules framed thereunder, and the accreditation is renewed up to the registered class. Apart from these classes, additional classes and extra sections are not permitted.
2. The school shall function under the rules framed under the Karnataka Education Act-1983 and the Child Rights Education Act-2009.
3. Child Rights to Education Act-2009 to reserve 25% seats for weaker section children under the rules framed thereunder. The Government has the authority to enrol the reserved seats under RTE for the schools covered by RTE. [Government has framed rules to facilitate the enrolment of children in neighbouring schools where their parents live, according to which, if there are government or government-aided educational institutions, children will be enrolled in that school] Otherwise, private schools will be enrolled by the government.
4. Government releases fees of children enrolled under RTE rules as described in clause 3. Hence it has stopped charging any fees from these children.
5. Any capitation fee and voluntary donations by the school and school management from the parents at the time of enrolment.
6. The school / management body shall publish the information on the fees collected from the parents of the children in their school as tuition fees vide State Government Notification No: ED:31:PGC:2019, dated:27.07.2019 on the departmental website and on the school notice board. No fee shall be charged in excess of the prescribed fee.
7. The School / Governing Body shall enrol the students within the period fixed by the Govt.
8. The School / Governing Body cannot refuse enrolment against the following points.
 - i. Due to lack of proof and age.
 - ii. On the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language.
 - iii. If admission is sought after extended period of admission.
9. Carrying out all safety measures as per RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules. [Fire safety and building safety certificate from concerned authorities and child learning safety as per K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R].

10. The School / Governing Body is as follow.

- (i) in any class till the completion of primary education and secondary education of any admitted
- ii) Not to be held back or expelled from school. (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical or mental abuse.
- (iii) No child shall be required to pass any board examination till completion of primary education.
- (iv) Every child who completes primary education is issued a certificate as prescribed under Rule 21 of RTE and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
- (v) As per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules the school shall also admit children with special needs / special children.
- (vi) Appointed teachers shall possess the minimum qualifications as prescribed for primary and high school teachers in the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders.
- (vii) Salary and allowances payable to teachers and terms and conditions of service shall be as prescribed by the State Government. And salaries are paid to teachers through government notification [Prospective Fund (P)] and payable bank and other salaries and subject to Employee State Insurance (ESI).
- (viii) Teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section 24[1] of the Act and the RTE Act and Rules and Rule 17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for supervisory considerations.

11. Adherence to the academic state curriculum and state text books to which the school is affiliated.

12. The school shall maintain the norms and standards as specified in Section-19 of the Karnataka Education Act. Appointment of departmental staff as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

13. School buildings and other basic facilities associated with the school should not be given over to any commercial activities or political and non-educational activities during the day or night.

13. School buildings and other basic facilities associated with the school should not be given over to any commercial activities or political and non-educational activities during the day or night.

14. The school shall not be run for the benefit of any person or group or association.

15. Get the school audited by a Chartered Accountant and submit the copy to the Deputy Director / Field Education Officer by the end of June every year.

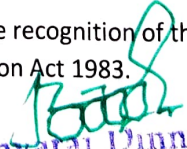
16. The School shall follow the Language Policy as per Government Notification [Kannada Language Policy-2016]

22. In case of violation of the above condition as per the rules framed under RTE Act 2009 and Karnataka Education Act 1983. The recognition of the school will be cancelled.

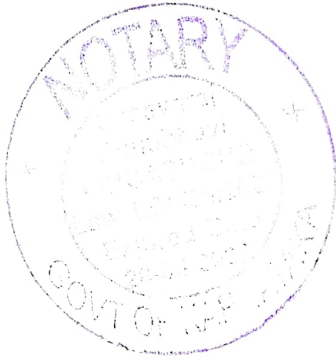
